Addressing the Abuse of Older Women and Men:

Building a Multidisciplinary Intersectoral Hospital-based Elder Abuse Intervention

Elder Abuse is a serious and growing public health issue worldwide. Between 2-10% of older adults in Ontario are estimated to be victims of Elder Abuse (Elder Abuse Ontario, 2014). The magnitude of the problem will continue to increase as the population ages; the number of older adults in Ontario will nearly double to 4.1 million by 2035. Despite the gravity of elder abuse in Ontario, there is no standard, province-wide provision of dedicated care for abused older adults at hospital-based violence treatment centres.

To address this gap, Women's College Research Institute (WCRI) and the Ontario Network of Sexual Assault/Domestic Violence Treatment Centres in collaboration with Elder Abuse Ontario have advanced a multi-phase, multi-method program of research to develop, implement, and evaluate a Multidisciplinary Intersectoral Hospital-based Elder Abuse Intervention building on the infrastructure of Ontario's 35 sexual assault nurse examiner-led violence treatment centres. Over the past 3 years, three of the five phases of this project have been completed.

Please join us on April 13th for an interactive and informative discussion to share some of the key findings from this *Elder Abuse Intervention Project*. During this webinar, you will learn about the different research methods that have been utilized in the development phases of the *Elder Abuse Intervention Project* (e.g., Systematic Scoping Review, Modified Delphi Consensus Survey) and the findings to date including a model of potential participating professionals important to a comprehensive hospital-based elder abuse intervention with formalized links to the community, allied health and legal sectors and the results of a pilot of a new Elder Abuse Nurse Examiner curriculum.

We will also be welcoming your feedback concerning future intersectoral collaboration between the hospital-based violence treatment centres and the services in your community that comprise local Elder Abuse Networks.
